

Hall of Fame Nomination Eligibility Requirements:

For a player to be nominated to the SWBL Hall of Fame ballot, they must have played in the league as a non-bench player for at least 7 seasons before the current season of play begins, PLUS three of the four following extra eligibility requirements:

- SWBL Champion
- At least two major SWBL Awards
- Two-Time All Star
- Front Office Statistics Review

The SWBL Commissioner can also nominate advocates or players that do not meet these requirements.

Retired and active players are both eligible to be nominated.

Hall of Fame Induction Eligibility Requirements:

To be selected into the SWBL Hall of Fame, the nominated player must be on at least 80% of all voting ballots.

There is no maximum amount of players that can be selected into the Hall of Fame each year, but there also does not have to be a new member selected each year if no nominee receives 80% of the needed votes.

Hall of Fame Voting Eligibility Requirements:

SWBL Hall of Fame voting members include:

- Players currently in the SWBL Hall of Fame
- Current or Past SWBL Front Office Members

OR anyone else who meets the following three requirements:

- 7 years non-bench playing experience before the current season begins.
- Annually write an article for the SWBL Website.
- Attend the Friday, closed, Hall of Fame meeting after the SWBL Opening Ceremony Social Night.

Each voting member can vote for UP TO 50% of the nominated players from the current season's ballot.

If you are a voting member and also nominated for the Hall of Fame, you will not be allowed to vote for yourself.
